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








Burke County Unemployme Agenda ate, June 2010 – June 2016




Burke County Labor Force and Magendate er of Employed Persons, June 2010 – June 2016




Burke County Employment, 1st Qtr 2006-2016



Educational Attainment for Pagenda lation Age 25 and Over, 2010-2014 ACS






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Valdese Housing Statistics Agenda 2010-2014 ACS Total Housing Units = 2,103




